

Apart from winning the Triangular Athletics meeting here at Denbury, our athletes carried all before them at Taunton, where they emerged vic-torious in the Army Boys Athletics Championships (Preliminary Round), and came second in the Army Boys Athletic Championships Finals.

Individually, J/Sig. Smith (Javelin Troop) has taken the honours, and is the Victor Ludorum for this year. Apart from his other achievements, we wish further to congratulate Smith on having been chosen to represent the Army team in the 440 yards in the first Inter-Services Junior Championships, which were held at the Royal Air Force Station, St. Athan, on July 28.
