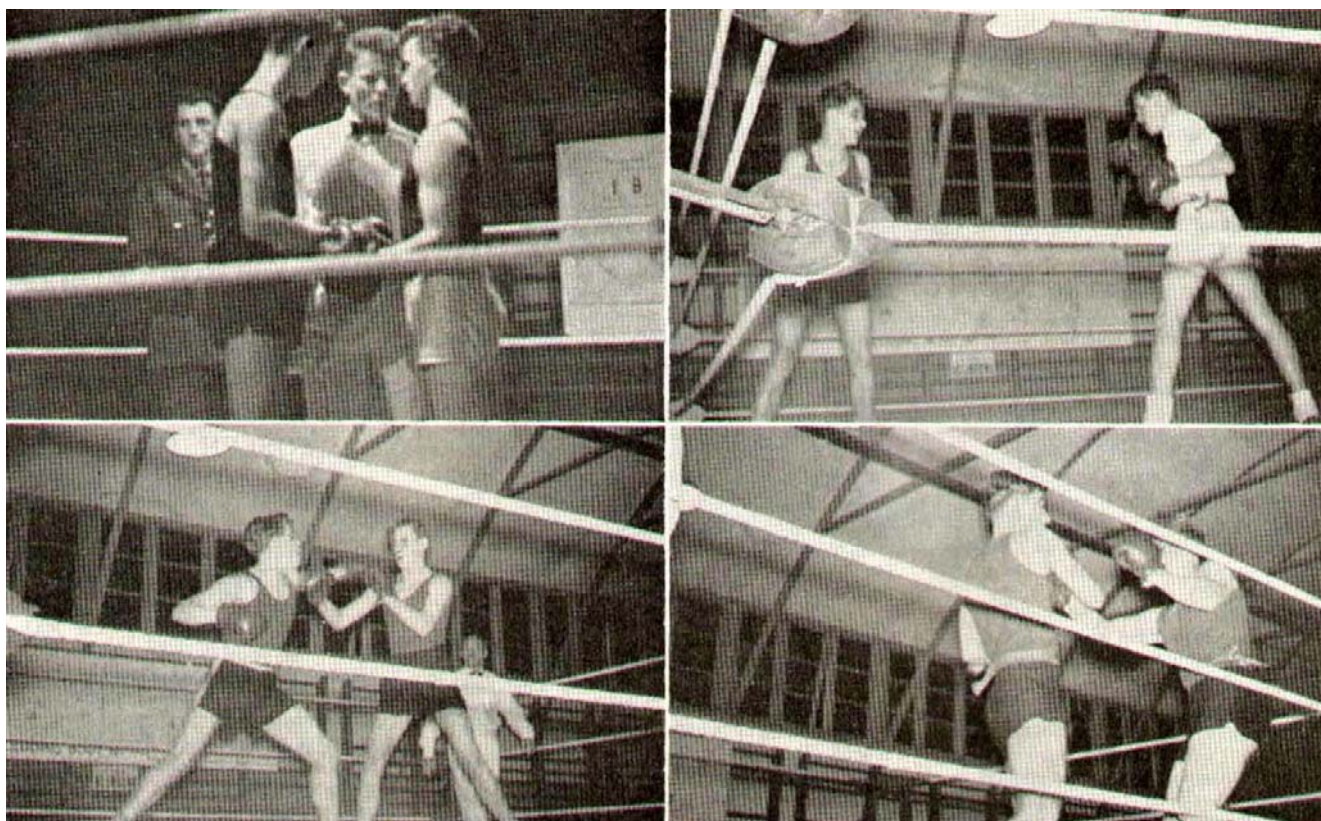

ATHLETICS

ARMY BOYS ATHLETIC CHAMPIONSHIPS (PRELIMINARY ROUND), JUNE 27, 1962

This has been the finest year for Athletics since the Regiment moved down to Denbury.

Apart from winning the Triangular Athletics meeting here at Denbury, our athletes carried all before them at Taunton, where they emerged victorious in the Army Boys Athletics Championships (Preliminary Round), and came second in the Army Boys Athletic Championships Finals.

Individually, J/Sig. Smith (Javelin Troop) has taken the honours, and is the Victor Ludorum for this year. Apart from his other achievements, we wish further to congratulate Smith on having been chosen to represent the Army team in the 440 yards in the first Inter-Services Junior Championships, which were held at the Royal Air Force Station, St. Athan, on July 28.

AWARD OF VICTOR LUDORUM TROPHY

It has been customary for this trophy to be awarded to the athlete who has achieved the highest standing in his event, while at the same time remaining a permanent member of the Regimental team.
