MOVEMENT ORDER - JUNIOR LEADERS TO HARROGATE

1. GENERAL

Junior Leaders as per Annex 'A' attached, proceeding from the Regiment to the Army Apprentices College, Uniacke Barracks, Harrogate are to disperse and reassemble in accordance with this instruction.

2. LEAVE

Junior Leaders are granted leave from AD 15 Aug 67 until 1600 hrs 11 Sep 67.

3. REPORTING - HARROGATE

Junior Leaders are to report individually to the Guardroom, Army Apprentices College, Uniacke Barracks, Harrogate by 1600 hrs 11 Sep 67.

West Yorkshire buses on normal service leave the station at Harrogate for Uniacke Barracks (Pennypot Lane).

4. PAY

Junior Leaders are to be paid up to and including 8 Sep 67 on Tue 15 Aug 67 under Troop arrangements.

5. LEAVE PASSES

To be issued under Troop/Squadron arrangements as normal.

6. RAILWAY WARRANTS

'A' Squadron to issue railway warrants as follows :

- a. Newton Abbot to leave address
- b. Leave address to Harrogate

7. CLEARANCE CERTIFICATES

Clearance certificate (in duplicate) is to be completed before departure from this Regiment.



8. KIT

- b. Kit bags are to be labelled with tie on label and loaded into a British Rail container on or about 11 Aug 67 under Squadron arrangements.
- c. These kit bags will be collected on arrival at Harrogate.
- d. All other items of kit are to be taken by individuals on leave. No personal kit is to be left in Denbury Camp.
- e. Junior Leaders are to ensure they are in possession of all their kit, less that listed at Annex 'B', on arrival at Harrogate.

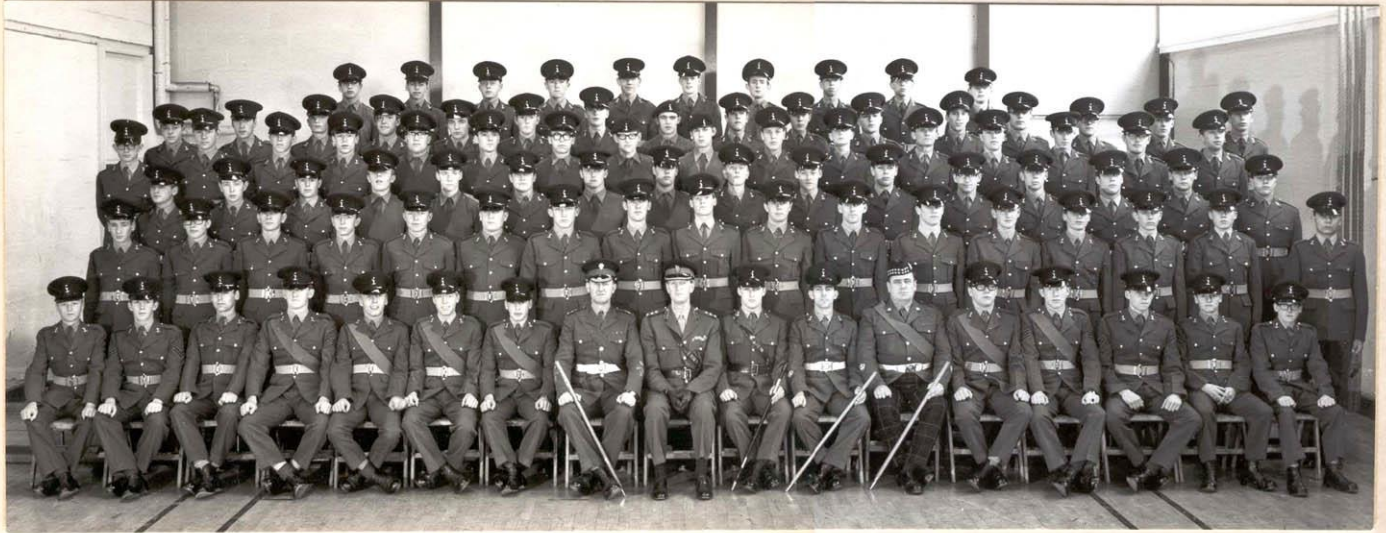


Members of the last Denbury intake Sep 66 on exercise in Yorkshire

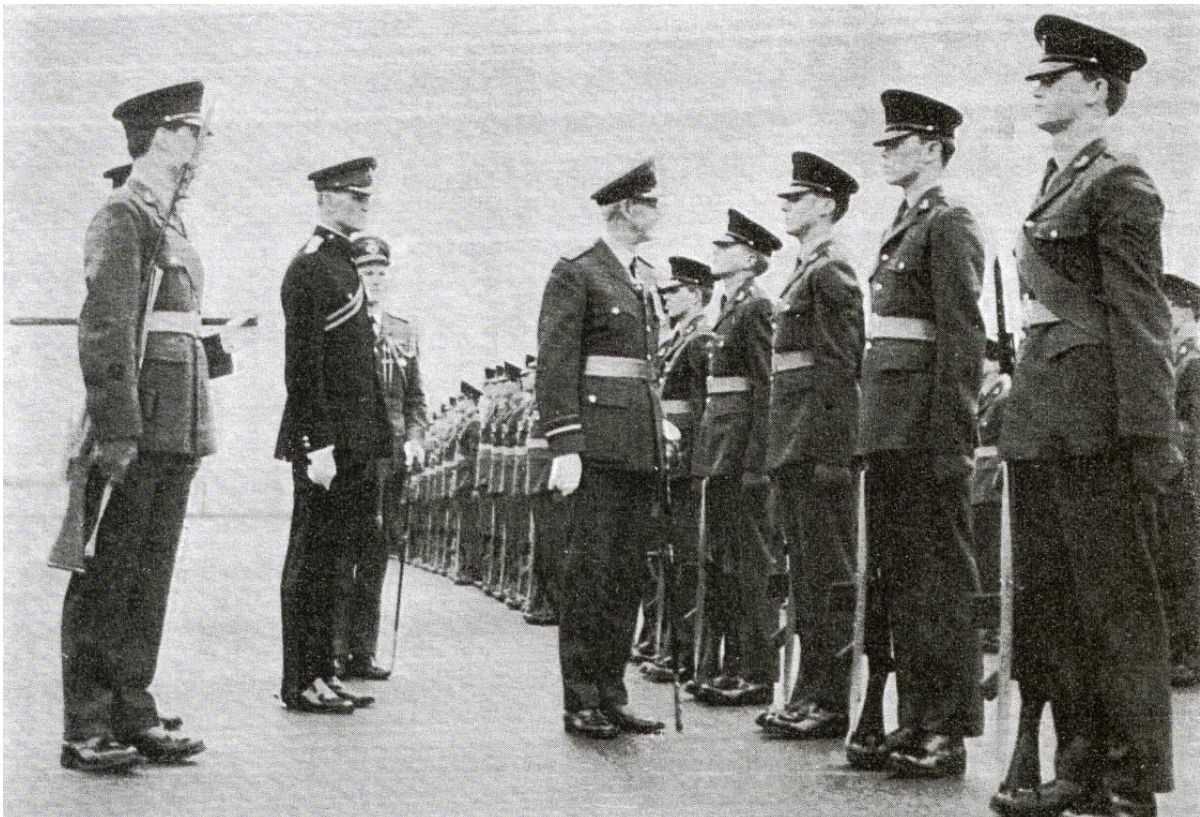

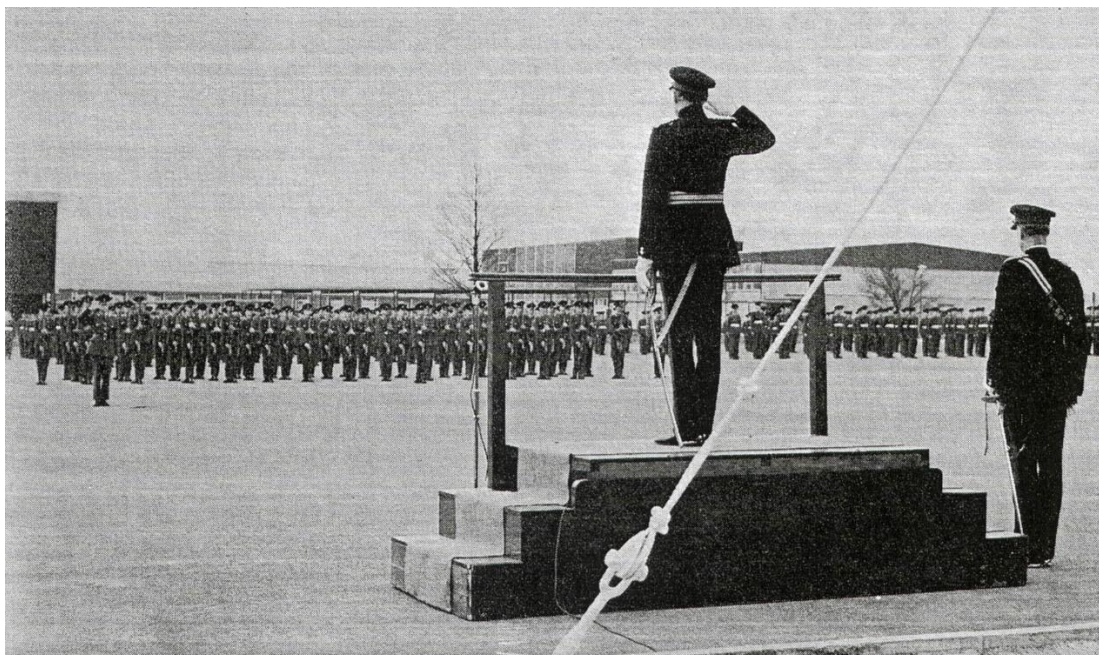
